



GEMs: The ICD-10 TRANSITION

Course Description

GEMs: The ICD-10 Transition is an introductory course to the General Equivalence Mapping tool created by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), with assistance from both the American Hospital Association (AHA) and the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA).

Course Summary

This course will benefit users of ICD-9-CM coded data who are exploring assistance in the ICD-10 transition. The course covers the critical GEMs-related details to supply individuals with the necessary background and knowledge to assist with the data conversion.

A coding book is NOT NEEDED to take this course.

The course concludes with a 45-question self-assessment test to assess your practical knowledge of the skills reviewed. A passing score of 70% or higher is necessary to obtain 4 CEUs (see CE Credits in top tab for more details).
